# 2 ACC 3 Release History

This section lists all software releases for ACC 3.

#### 2.1 Version 3.0.0

Exact software version: 3.0.0 Release date: 08.10.2010

This is the initial release for the Windows software ACC 3.

It supports playlist creation and export for DigiPoster-4.3, DigiPoster-II, DigiPoster-III and ArtistaMEDIA / VideoPoster.

## 2.2 Version 3.2.0

Exact software version: 3.2.0 Release date: 24.11.2010

#### New features:

- Undo-redo functionality
- Cut-copy-paste functionality
- Logging functionality
- MP4 video files support
- PDF import functionality
- · Can choose to keep aspect ratio for scaled images

#### **Changes:**

· Main toolbar replaced with a tab-bar to accommodate growing functionality

#### Fixes:

VideoPoster resolution for NTSC is now correctly shown in the status bar (ticket #2010102510000012)

#### New features:

#### New features:

- Playlist import functionality (download remote playlist from device or open locally exported playlist)
- Can mark files to be excluded from upload (for files uploaded by 3rd party)
- Support for VideoPoster-III devices
- Resize of preview window works properly
- Opens maximized if previously closed in maximized state

#### Changes:

- Comfortably set or open encoder output folder form the encoder toolbar (moved from the settings dialog)
- Switched to a newer FFmpeg version (0.10)
- "Length" table column width is now fixed

#### New features:

- Added the functionality to define events for playlist selection on the media-player. Now it is possible to
  use the Artista I/O board or the HttpCtrl network protocol to switch between different sub-playlists
- VideoPoster-III with firmware version 1.2.0 and above supports the WMV (Windows Media Video) and the F4V (Adobe Flash Video) video formats. ACC exports these formats without encoding now
- If ACC is used to export a playlist to connected media-players, it shows the result (success or error) of the content update immediately now. This feature is supported by DigiPoster-4.3, DigiPoster-III and VideoPoster-III with their latest firmware versions
- Added support for the new VideoPoster-III display resolution 1280 x 800

#### **Changes:**

- Upgraded the Qt libraries to version 4.8.2
- The dialog for exporting playlists to devices does not close automatically any more. The user can look at the result and close the dialog manually now
- Optimized repeated export of playlists with still images. ACC does not reprocess images any more, if they have been processed for a previous playlist export already

#### Fixes:

- Fixed the issue, where ACC lost the reference to media files in some cases, if the playlist has been saved as project before
- Fixed the issue, where the orientation of newly added images was wrong on displays in portrait mode, if the playlist has been imported into ACC from the device before
- Fixed the issue, where multiple media files could not be added to an ACC playlist in one step, if the files are stored in the Desktop folder



# 2.14 Version 3.20.0

Exact software version: 3.20.0.38418 Release date: 31.10.2012

#### New features:

 Added a new "Device Manager" tab. It replaces the "Connections" dialog in the settings menu and improves the administration of the connected media-players. It allows logical grouping of the devices now

#### Changes:

- The "Connections" dialog for content upload and download has been removed and the "Device Manager" tab has been introduced instead
- During the upload of a setup file to a FTP server, the file has the extension ".part" now. After the upload is finished, the file is renamed to its original name. This helps the devices to recognize if the upload is still in progress or has been finished
- The current size and position of the ACC window on the Windows desktop is saved now. This makes sure, that the application appears with the same size and position when it has been closed and reopened
- Upgraded the Qt libraries to version 4.8.3

## 2.15 Version 3.20.1

Exact software version: 3.20.1.38545 Release date: 12.11.2012

#### Fixes:

- Fixed the issue, where it was not possible to add a file to the playlist, when a different file with the same name was in the playlist already. Now it is possible to add this file. But the new file gets renamed with a filename suffix by ACC automatically when the playlist is exported or saved as a project
- Fixed the issue, where the files in a playlist project disappeared when a new file has been added to the playlist and the project has been saved again
- Fixed the issue, where it was not possible to change the settings of an existing FTP server



### 2.16 Version 3.22.0

Exact software version: 3.22.0.38986 Release date: 09.01.2013

#### New features:

- Added the device monitoring functionality. The Device Manager shows the current status of all connected media-players now. The firmware of the media-player needs to support the monitoring feature (currently supported by VideoPoster-III v1.8.0 and above). ACC checks the status of the devices in local networks every 3 minutes automatically. Devices which are installed remote and connected to a FTP server, report their current status every 3 minutes to the FTP server which is checked by ACC as well. ACC shows the device status "Online", "Warning", "Error" and "Offline". Further detailed information about the device (e.g. available memory space, etc.) is also available
- Devices which are installed remote and connected to a FTP server and support monitoring are autodetected by ACC now
- Extended the functionality to define events for playlist selection on the media-player. Now it is possible
  to send trigger commands via RS-232 to switch between different sub-playlists
- Added support for drag 'n drop for entries in the playlist view

#### Changes:

- Introduced a transfer dialog, which shows progress and status information for all network actions like playlist upload or download
- The "Events" dialog to define playlist events has been moved from the "Settings" menu to the main window of ACC

#### New features:

- Added content update confirmation for remote devices (e.g. VideoPoster-III devices connected to an FTP-bridge-server)
- Added concurrent image export processing using all available processor cores

To preview AVI video files (video format formerly used by ArtistaMEDIA / VideoPoster) in ACC please install "ffdshow" additionally and enable "MPEG in AVI" video container (choose either "libmpeg2" or "libavcodec").
